Destin	49,239	24.22%	Five classes were added in 04/05 which contributed to the overall increase in cash receipts (field trips, teacher supply money, fund raising, etc). The 4th grade took a trip to Orlando that had not been taken in the prior year.
Lula J. Edge	23,874	17.77%	The school added a few new fundraisers during 04-05. The Cherrydale and Cookie dough fundraisers were very profitable and increased cash (\$16k). The Honor choir fundraiser also increased cash (\$3k).
James E. Plew	(25,151)	-15.89%	There was a decrease in enrollment which contributed to a decrease in field trips, fund raisers and donations. There was also a decrease in picture money.
Max Bruner, Jr.	(108,407)	-28.73%	There was a large decrease in receipts (\$50K) due to the turnover of band and chorus directors in 04-05, both took trips in 03-04 that were not taken in 04-05. Also due to Hurricane Ivan the school fundraiser produced less sales (\$28K). Athletics had smaller revenues in their fundraisers (\$25K).
Davidson	46,939	21.67%	Athletics increased due to fundraising for summer football coaching (new in 04-05); also hosted the football jamboree. Music increased due to Band & Chorus fundraising for new uniforms and trips to Disney and State competitions. Clubs increased due to adding a newspaper.
Destin Middle at Regatta Bay	54,995	16.33%	Athletics increased the number of fund raisers and the Beta Club received a donation of \$20,000 for state competition.
W. C. Pryor	26,768	-17.14%	Classes decreased because of a 20% decrease in students, and over-collection of activity fees in 03-04, reducing the amount needed in 04-05. Departments decreased because one fundraiser was discontinued.
Lance C. Richbourg	31,251	17.30%	Music increased because school collected funds from all Okaloosa middle schools for the Chorus All-State Conference, and the Chorus raised funds for new uniforms. Classes increased due to funds collected for additional field trips.
