#### INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

### **NOTE 1 - REPORTING ENTITY**

The Okaloosa County District School Board (District) has direct responsibility for operation, control, and supervision of Okaloosa County schools and is considered a primary government for financial reporting. The District is considered part of the Florida system of public education. The governing body is the School Board of Okaloosa County which is composed of five elected members. The elected Superintendent of Schools is the executive officer of the School Board. Geographic boundaries of the District correspond with those of Okaloosa County.

Individual schools within the District are considered separate entities with regards to the accounting and reporting of their internal funds.

### NOTE 2 - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

### **Basis of Accounting**

The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting, which is an other comprehensive basis of accounting, and is not intended to present fairly the financial position and results of operations of the District in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America. Under the cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting, the only asset recognized is cash, and no liabilities are recognized. All transactions are recognized as either cash receipts or disbursements, and non-cash transactions are not recorded.

### Cash

For purposes of the Statement of Cash Receipts and Disbursements, the District considers all unrestricted highly liquid investments with an initial maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents. Substantially all of the District's cash balances at June 30, 2008 consist of deposits held by banks qualified as public depositories under Florida law or amounts placed with the State Board of Administration for participation in the Local Government Surplus Funds Trust Fund Investment Pool.

### **NOTE 3 – SCHOOL CLOSINGS**

During the year ended June 30, 2008, the District closed Oak Hill Elementary School. All internal funds of Oak Hill Elementary School were transferred in August 2007 to Eglin Elementary School (formally known as Cherokee Elementary School). In addition, the District consolidated Crestview Vocational Technical Center with Crestview High School. All internal funds of Crestview Vocational Technical Center were transferred in July 2007 to Crestview High School.

In addition, subsequent to June 30, 2008, Ocean City Elementary School closed. Once all matters are completed and certificates of deposit have matured, the remaining funds will be transferred amongst Wright Elementary, Shalimar Elementary, and Longwood Elementary Schools.

### MANAGEMENT LETTER

To the Okaloosa County District School Board and Dr. Alexis Tibbetts, Superintendent of Schools Fort Walton Beach, Florida

In planning and performing our audit of the statements of cash receipts and disbursements for the internal funds of the schools of the Okaloosa County School District as of and for the year ended June 30, 2008, in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, we considered the District's internal control over financial reporting (internal control) as a basis for designing our auditing procedures for the purpose of expressing our opinion on the financial statements but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the District's internal control. Accordingly, we do not express an opinion on the effectiveness of the District's internal control.

Our consideration of internal control was for the limited purpose described in the first paragraph and would not necessarily identify all deficiencies in internal control that might be significant deficiencies or material weaknesses. A material weakness is a significant deficiency, or a combination of significant deficiencies, that results in more than a remote likelihood that a material misstatement of the financial statements will not be prevented or detected by the entity's internal control. We did not identify any deficiencies in internal control that we consider to be material weaknesses, as defined above.

However, during our audit we became aware of matters that are opportunities for strengthening internal controls and operating efficiencies. Our comments and suggestions regarding those matters are listed in the attached exhibits. A summary of all findings is presented below. This letter does not affect our report dated November 19, 2008 on the statements of cash receipts and disbursements of the District.

### **DESTIN MIDDLE SCHOOL - Exhibit A**

• Improper disbursement procedures

Check Requisition/Transfer Forms not properly signed by the principal were noted in our sample.

### **SILVER SANDS SCHOOL** - Exhibit B

• Untimely deposits - teachers/sponsors

We noted multiple instances in our sample of monies collected in excess of \$10 that were not turned into the office in a timely manner.

We will review the status of these comments during our next audit engagement. We have already discussed these comments and suggestions with the principals and bookkeepers, as well as the District's accounting staff, and we will be pleased to discuss them in further detail at your convenience, to perform any additional study of these matters, or to assist you in implementing the recommendations.

The Okaloosa County School District Internal Accounting Manual, Section 1.142 Check Requistion/Transfer Form states, "... The completed form is forwarded to the school principal, who must approve the request before any expenditure of School Activity Funds may be made."

1. During our audit, we noted numerous instances in our sample where the principal had not signed the form, thus indicating their approval.

### Recommendation

 We recommend that the principal sign the required form which documents his/her authorization to disburse the funds.

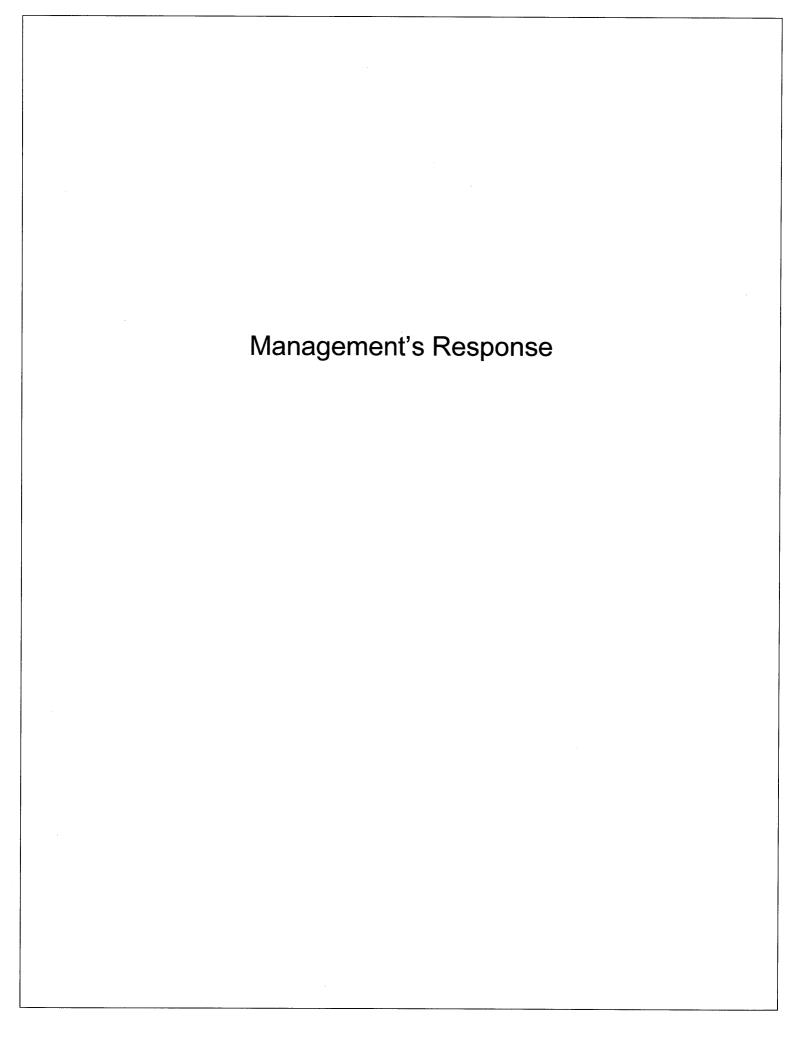

### **UNTIMELY DEPOSITS - TEACHERS/SPONSORS**

The Okaloosa County School District Internal Accounting Manual, Section 1.009 (1) states, "... Collections made outside of the school office, which exceed \$10 in the aggregate must be turned into the office daily." In our sample selected, we noted numerous instances in which monies collected in excess of \$10 were not turned into the office until weeks after the initial collection date.

### Recommendation

 We recommend that monies collected be turned into the office – by use of the drop safe – on a daily basis.
