Class Size Reduction is the categorical program in the Governor's Proposed Budget for FY 2005-2006 which funds the operational costs associated with implementing the 2005-2006 constitutional amendment requirements to reduce the pupil/teacher ratio. Amendment IX of the Florida Constitution requires a maximum class size for grades pre-kindergarten through 3 to be 18 students, for grades 4 through 8 to be 22, and grades 9 through 12 to be 25. For 2004-2005 and 2005-2006 the requirements for implementation of the Class Size Amendment were to reduce the class size on a district-level by 2 students per class for each category or to meet the Class Size Amendment requirement for each category at the district-level. While Amendment IX requires each school within the District to meet the constitutional class size by grade-level no later than 2006-2007, the District met the district-level requirement in all grade levels in 2004-2005 as well as the school-level requirement at all except one school within the District. This is two years prior to the constitutionally mandated time frame of 2006-2007.

For FY 2005-2006, the District will allocate the same number of instructional units to each school as in 2004-2005 and schools will be expected to meet the class size requirement by grade-level of 18 for grades pre-kindergarten through 3,22 for grades 4 through 8, and 25 for grades 9 through 12.

Prior to the October 2005 FTE Survey, MIS will provide periodic reports with preliminary class size calculations for each grade-level group at each school. Both MIS and Finance will work closely with schools to assist schools in meeting the class size requirements.

For budgeting purposes, there is a section on the Salary Menu (MIS 3382) for your school for Class Size Reduction - Project 4125. Finance has already entered the number of units allocated to your school. By Constitutional mandate, schools may not cash in these positions or use the funds for any other purpose.

During the scheduling process, schools should work closely with Management Information Systems (MIS) to ensure compliance with class size requirements. Additionally, school principals will again be asked to certify the following: (1) they have purchased the number of positions required to meet class size reduction requirements; and (2) for middle schools only, they have not used Class Size Reduction positions to supplant.

## Appendix C

## Maximum Class Size and Class Load

## Definitions:

Class Size is the number of students assigned to a teacher for a period of instruction. In elementary schools, where one teacher directs all learning, it is the number of pupils for whom a teacher is responsible daily. In secondary schools or other schools in which teachers are responsible for instruction in a particular subject, it is the number of pupils for whom a teacher is responsible during a single period.

Class Load is the number of pupils for whom teachers are responsible daily where the teacher is assigned more than one class each day.

If a class consists of two grades, whichever of the two grades' maximum class size is the smallest shall be the maximum class size for that class. In addition, the $10 \%$ beyond provision of Article VI shall not apply in the case of combination classes.
