

OKALOOSA COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT Governor's Reading Instruction - Literacy Coaches School Year 2005-2006

The proposed Governor's Budget for fiscal year 2005-2006 contains a specific line item allocation for Reading Instruction. The District will use these funds to provide ongoing embedded professional development support for schools through Literacy Coaches. These funds will be used in conjuction with Title II - Part A funds for the Literacy Coach program. Full-time Literacy Coaches will be placed in all elementary schools, and middle school Literacy Coaches will be increased from half-time to full-time. The embedded professional development activities provided by the Literacy Coaches are directly related to student achievement issues and reflect intensive efforts to increase achievement through the more highly developed cognitive base of teachers in the area of literacy. A priority focus for Literacy Coaches during the 2005-2006 school year will be support for secondary intensive reading teachers at both the middle and high schools.
