

Okaloosa County School District Fixed Charges for ESE Student Services School Year 2005-2006

Fixed Charges for ESE Student Services consist of a revenue allocation and an expenditure charge for Itinerant ESE services provided to students at schools and is funded from the ESE Guarantee revenue portion of FEFP.

The amount of the fixed charge for these services is 100% offset by a revenue allocation in the same amount as the charge.
