

OKALOOSA COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT Title II - Part A - Literacy Coaches School Year 2005-2006

Title II-Part A funds are targeted to provide ongoing embedded professional development support for schools through Literacy Coaches. All Title II funds will be expended to provide partial support for the Literacy Coach program in personnel and other associated costs. Full-time Literacy Coaches will be placed in elementary schools, and middle school Literacy Coaches will be increased from half-time to full-time. The embedded professional development activities provided by the Literacy Coaches are directly related to student achievement issues and reflect intensive efforts to increase achievement through the more highly developed cognitive base of teachers in the area of literacy. A priority focus for Literacy Coaches during the 2005-2006 school year will be support for secondary intensive reading teachers at both the middle and high schools.
