### Phase II - Grades K-5

Considering that the District is in the process of starting construction on new classrooms in 2006-2007 and in order to obtain as many additional teachers as financially possible, we are recommending that hiring an additional 30 teachers (grades K-5 and ESE). The teachers (23) will be assigned to each school which has grades K-5, and the District will maintain a reserve of 7 teaching units to be filled and assigned as necessary. (Exhibit C) The "Class Size Reduction – Instructional Pool" teachers will function as substitute teachers at the assigned school.

Further information regarding the hiring and placement of the teachers will be provided by Human Resources.
