In 2005-2006, the District implemented the "Secondary Reading Initiative," a School Board directive to provide a comprehensive reading program requiring all non-proficient (FCAT Level 1 and Level 2) middle and high school readers to take a reading course. The initial funding for 2008-2009 is for the specific purpose of providing instructional staff (reading endorsed teachers), classroom assistants and classroom and assessment materials necessary to continue the program for 2008-2009.
