The primary portion of the Florida Education Finance Program is the base funding calculation. The projected revenue for schools incorporates the factors of the FEFP base funding calculation as the primary portion of the schools' discretionary budgets.

Please note that Projected Unweighted FTE for your school may have been adjusted for a change that occurred as a result of the following:

- UFTE from Ocean City Elementary School to Longwood Elementary School, Mary Esther Elementary, Shalimar Elementary School, and Wright Elementary School.
- UFTE from Destin Elementary School to Destin Middle School;
- ESE UFTE from Ocean City Elementary School to Edwins Elementary School and Kenwood Elementary School;
- ESE UFTE from Bob Sikes Elementary School to Walker Elementary School;
- ESE UFTE from Okaloosa Applied Technology Center to Choctawhatchee High School, Crestview High School, Ft. Walton Beach High School, Niceville High School and Lewis Middle School;
- ESE UFTE from Bluewater Elementary School to Destin Elementary School; and
- Final Conference Projected UFTE was less <u>320.69 UFTE</u> than the District's Projected UFTE.
