Allocation Amount: DJJ Supplement per WFTE \$ 902.03

x District Cost Differential (DCD) x 0.9818
= Net DJJ Supplement per WFTE 885.61
x 90% to DJJ Schools x 90%
= Net DJJ Supplement per WFTE @ 90% \$ 797.05
