

SCHOOL DISTRICT OF OKALOOSA COUNTY SAI - SECONDARY INTENSIVE MATH FISCAL YEAR 2017-2018

AS OF JUNE 2017

The District will use flexible Supplemental Academic Instruction (SAI) funding to provide smaller class sizes for non-proficient middle school students via an Intensive Math Program. The Curriculum, Instruction, & Assessment Department will provide detailed information about the Secondary Intensive Math Program to applicable secondary schools.

The funding for the Secondary Intensive Math Program enables schools to have smaller class sizes of 16 students each.

Project Number: 8121

Allocation Method: Same as previous fiscal year, except for change of funding source from CSR to SAI.

Net Increase to Make Smaller Class Sizes

<u>Classroom Assistant Allocation</u> Classroom Assistants allocated through SAI - Secondary Intensive Reading may also assist

with the intensive math program.

When classroom allocations for the entire school are calculated, schools are allocated enough teachers to meet class size. These positions are funded through a combination of Discretionary and Class Size Reduction.

The Intensive Math calculation is then made using smaller class sizes than contractually and legally required. Since the students were already accounted for in the original calculations made, the District deducts a portion of the Intensive Math Teacher Units from the units allocated through the Discretionary budget. The net effect is normally an increase of a period or two to make class sizes smaller.
