If the primary service provider is not able to respond and/or complete a project within the necessary timeframe, the secondary provider shall be utilized. Should the secondary service provider be unable to respond and/or complete a project within the necessary timeframe, the district reserves the right to acquire the services specified herein from any other source or via any other procurement method deemed by the School Board of Okaloosa County to be in its best interest. The board reserves the right to waive any informality, to make mathematical correction to error/s in any bid, waive any minor irregularity or technicality in bids received or to reject any or all bids or any portion thereof that is in the best interest of the board.
