We would like to amend our current contract that was awarded for the ITB 23-08 Locksmith Services. Through recent discoveries working at multiple schools it has been brought to our attention that our original bid was not written properly to cover all the different manufacturers of locks and door hardware that will be required for the remainder of this contract.

We will be giving a 15% discount off of Manufacturers Published Price List (MPPL) on the following manufacturers: Arrow, Best, Cal Royal, Corbin Russwin, Dor-o-matic, Dorma-Kaba, Falcon, Hager, Jackson, LSDA, Monarch, Norton, PDQ, Yale, Schlage, Kwikset, Von Duprin, ASSA ABLOY, Sargent, General Lock, Master lock.

Other changes that need to be made to the bid:

Automotive mobile opening: is \$0 + Service call of \$75.00 or emergency of \$95.00

Remove and Replace standard cylindrical lock: is \$20.00 rather then \$45.00

Change Safe combo: is \$50.00 rather then \$125.00

Mistakes were made when making the original bid where we included our service call into the prices of some things so these changes should suffice as we now properly understand the way the billing process works with you guys.
