Current employees in the District who are promoted to a administrative position from the instructional or educational support salary schedule shall be placed on the salary schedule in the appropriate pay grade at the lowest step which reflects an increase in pay, and shall move a step each year until they reach the top step.

If a current employee has experience outside of the District, specifically in administrative positions, they will be placed on the administrative salary schedule to reflect that experience if it would result in an increase in pay. It is the employees responsibility to provide Personnel with the said experience at the time of the promotion.

Adjustments for degrees are made after initial placement unless it results in a decrease in pay from the original salary of the employee in which case we adjust upward so that no loss occurs.

Employees who receive promotions from the administrative, managerial or professional/technical salary schedules will be moved laterally from their current step to the appropriate step.

New hires to the district shall receive credit for "administrative experience only." Credit will not be given for years the administrator is currently drawing retirement on. The maximum credit for administrative experience will be ten (10) years.

School based administrators who are designated outstanding by the Pay for Performance Plan will receive an additional 5% of their individual base salary.
