Recommended Motion to approve the award of RFP 14-02 Cued Speech Transliterating Services. The recommended award is to Sharon Romero at an hourly rate of \$50.00 for an estimated 1,425 hours, for a total estimated contract amount of \$71,250.00. All funds will be paid from Federal Funds, Project 4475, IDEA Part B. The contract term is August 13, 2013

through June 9, 2014.

Public Content

The committee recommends the award of RFP 14-02 to Sharon Romero, who will provide cued speech transliterating services based on the student's Individual Education Plan (IEP). Services include the following:

- 1) monitoring the student in the classroom to assist student with accessing education;
- 2) consulting with teachers and other District staff;
- 3) maintaining any necessary documentation relevant to student progress;
- 4) serving as a member of the IEP team

The contractor will be paid an hourly rate of \$50.00 for an estimated 1,425 hours, for a total estimated contract amount of \$71,250.00. All funds will be paid from Federal Funds, Project 4475, IDEA Part B. The contract term is August 13, 2013 through June 9, 2014. A copy of the tabulation and recommendation is attached.
