Superintendent's recommendation and justification:

Upon consideration of the School Food Service Management Operations RFP 14-07 and the efforts of the RFP Selection Committee, my recommendation is that the School Board reject all proposals and re-advertise a revised RFP. Certain aspects of the Evaluation Criteria section found on pages 36-37 of the RFP are ambiguous. These ambiguities appear to have led to inconsistent approaches to scoring, which have resulted in scoring that appears to be unreliable. The re-advertised RFP should have additional language in the Evaluation Criteria section to unambiguously guide members of the Selection Committee on how to apply each category's score range to the proposals. The current RFP lacks this type of language for multiple important categories. The magnitude and importance of this contract make it particularly important that the Selection Committee is provided with unambiguous rules to follow when scoring proposals. My recommendation will ensure that all proposers are treated fairly and that the School Board selects the best proposal for our District.
