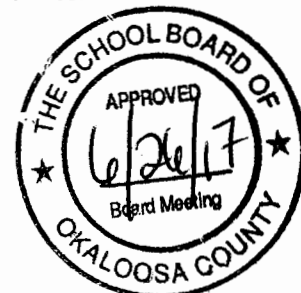

Public Content

Action, Rationale and Results:

The Food & Nutrition Services Department requests permission to renew Bid 3538AH which provides a percentage-off discount on large cafeteria equipment for use in all food service areas throughout the District. The supporting vendors have agreed to renew this bid using the same terms, conditions, and discounts established in 2015.

Methodology and Time Frame:

The supporting vendors are: Designs, Furnishings & Equipment of Daytona Beach, Florida and International Restaurant Distributors of Apopka, Florida. The estimated yearly expenditure for this renewal is \$600,000. The term of this renewal is from June 1, 2017 to May 31, 2018.

Effect of Action:

With this renewal the Food and Nutrition Services Department will be able to obtain large cafeteria equipment for use in all food service areas throughout the District using established discount pricing. This renewal will also benefit students and staff by continuing to provide nutritious meals efficiently and effectively without interruptions during school lunch times.

Policy or Statute:

This renewal complies with Florida State Statutes 287 and School Board Policy 7.70.



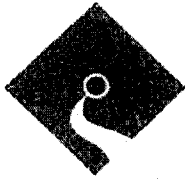
