SUBJECT: Stabilization Allocation - Project 0460

The State Fiscal Stabilization Fund (SFSF) program is a new one-time appropriation under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA). The U. S. Department of Education has awarded states approximately \$48.6 billion by formula under the SFSF program in exchange for a commitment to advance essential education reforms to benefit students from early learning through post-secondary education. These funds are intended to help stabilize state and local government budgets in order to minimize and avoid reductions in education and other essential public services. The program will help ensure that local educational agencies have the resources to **avert reductions and retain teachers**.

Attached you will find a spreadsheet reflecting the amount of each school's allocation for fiscal year 2009-2010. The allocation methodology is \$239 times each school's 2009-2010 projected unweighted FTE (UFTE).
