Lottery - School Advisory Council - Project 0002

At the beginning of fiscal year 2009-2010, school districts did not receive an allocation for Lottery - Discretionary (Project 3101) and Lottery - School Advisory Council (Project 0002). According to Senate Bill 2600, the only Lottery allocation made by the State was for School Recognition; however, the bill specified that if there were any funds remaining after payment to qualified schools, up to \$5.00 per unweighted student would be allocated to be used at the discretion of the school advisory council pursuant to sections 24.121(5) and 1001.452, Florida Statutes. The bill further stated that if funds were insufficient to provide \$5.00 per student, the available funds would be prorated.

The Third FEFP Calculation includes a Discretionary Lottery allocation for our District. These funds have been allocated to schools based on their estimated actual unweighted FTE as of the October 2009 FTE count. The funds will provide \$2.66 per unweighted FTE and have been allocated to Lottery - School Advisory Council (Project 0002). The attached spreadsheet indicates each school's allocation which has been placed in the following funding strip: 1010-5100-0510-Center-0002.
