SUBJECT: Materials and Supply Stipend

On September 27, 2010, the School Board approved to pay a stipend for materials and supplies to certified Adult Vocational Teachers, Occupational Therapists, Behavior Analysts, Physical Therapists, School Psychologists, Social Workers, and Staffing Specialists employed on or before September 1, 2010.

- Our District recognizes full-time teachers as those teachers working 4.5 hours or greater. Full-time teachers will receive a full stipend in the amount of \$202.00.
- Teachers working 3.75 hours to 4.49 hours will receive half of the full stipend amount which is \$101.00.

Attached you will find a list reflecting the names and positions that are eligible to receive the Materials and Supply stipend. The following requirements must be met when disbursing the stipends:

- If your school has an internal funds account, the attached check is made payable to your school. This check must be deposited into your school's internal funds bank account using Account 6.692.000 "FL Lead Teacher." The bookkeeper will then process a check for each individual teacher on the attached list.
- If your school does not have an internal funds account, the attached checks are made payable to the eligible teachers.
- Each teacher is required to sign the Materials and Supply Stipend agreement form (see attachment) when receiving his/her check. The agreement states that the teacher will keep all receipts and spend the funds for the sole purpose of purchasing classroom materials and supplies to be used in the instruction of students assigned to them. The teacher also agrees to return any unused funds to the school at the end of the school year. All checks must be received by the teachers no later than October 31, 2010.
- If a teacher returns unused funds to the school, those funds shall be remitted to the School District with a MIS 3218 Cash Transmittal Form no later than June 15, 2011.
- If there are any teachers at your school who are no longer eligible for the Materials and Supply Stipend, those funds shall be returned to the School District with a MIS 3218 Cash Transmittal Form no later than November 30, 2010.
