Title I Revised Allocation – Fiscal Year 2011-2012

Title I allocations were revised on May 11, 2011, and the revenue projection sheets were updated accordingly. The May 11, 2011, allocations were based on a State-projected reduction of 5% to 10%. The District has now received its allocation for fiscal year 2011-2012. The actual allocation is a significant increase rather than the previously anticipated reduction. Therefore, the District is making additional allocations at the school level.

The attached spreadsheet indicates the following information:

- Column A Base allocation as it was revised on May 20, 2011
- Column B Additional base allocation as of June 20, 2011
- Column C Total base allocation for fiscal year 2011-2012
- Column D 1% parental involvement allocation revised on May 20, 2011
- Column E Additional 1% parental involvement allocation as of June 20, 2011
- Column F Total 1% parental involvement allocation for fiscal year 2011-2012
- Column G Total Title I fiscal year 2011-2012 allocation (Column C + Column F)
- Column H 10% professional development set-aside requirement as of May 20, 2011
- Column I Additional 10% professional development set-aside requirement as of June 20,
- Column J Total 10% professional development set-aside requirement for fiscal year 2011-2012

The total additional allocation is the sum of Column B – Additional Base Allocation and Column E – Additional 1% Parental Involvement Allocation. This additional allocation will not be reflected on schools' revenue projection sheets; however, the funds will be budgeted to 4201.5100.0510.Center.2401 once the files roll.

At this time, schools may begin using these funds to purchase positions for fiscal year 2011-2012. Please enter an OASIS transaction (Purchase New Position) for the "2012 Regular School Year" and indicate that the funding will be Title I.
