AICE and AP Recalculation Based on 4th FEFP

Per TAM 2013-014 dated October 18, 2012, the District recalculated Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE – Projects 9004 and 1004) and Advanced Placement (AP – Projects 2154 and 7054) using WFTE earned as a result of the 2010-2011 AICE, AP, and IB student scores and/or diplomas.

When the 4th FEFP was released, there was a difference in WFTE earned for each of these programs. Information Systems has provided the revisions required to equal the 4th FEFP add-on WFTE, and Finance has recalculated the allocations based on this information. Attached are the following spreadsheets:

- Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) Projects 9004 & 1004 Revised Recalculation Based on 4th FEFP
