SUBJECT: Utility Allocation

Each school received an allocation for utilities as reflected in the fiscal year 2015-2016 School Budget Manual. The budget files have rolled, and each school's <u>budget allocation</u> for utilities has been moved from 1010.7900.0415.Center to School Utilities – Project 5099. The following school utilities formerly paid through Discretionary will be expended through Project 5099:

- Telephone, Including Long Distance
- Water and Sewer
- Garbage
- Natural Gas
- Electricity

CHOICE High School will continue to be responsible for 60% of its utilities to be expended through Workforce Development – Project 5110. Bottled Gas expenditures for Laurel Hill heating will be made through Project 5099.
