SUBJECT:

Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program - Prepayment

The Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program provides funding for certified teachers, employed on or before September 1, 2021, whose full-time job responsibility is the classroom instruction of students in prekindergarten through grade 12. It also provides funding for full time media specialists and guidance counselors who serve students in prekindergarten through grade 12.

Per Florida Legislation, the District has the option to prepay the Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program stipend to teachers, employed with the District on or before July 1, 2021, whose full-time job responsibility is the classroom instruction of students in prekindergarten through grade 12. The District has chosen to make this prepayment to these teachers.

The attached spreadsheet, "Eligible Teaching Positions as of July 1, 2021," indicates the number of eligible personnel at each school and the total allocation received. Our District recognizes full time teachers as those teachers working 4.50 hours or greater. These teachers will receive a stipend in the amount of \$320.00. Teachers who work 3.75 hours to 4.49 will receive a half stipend in the amount of \$160.00.

In September, the Budgeting Department will compile a list of teachers, employed on or before September 1, 2020, whose full-time job responsibility is the classroom instruction of students in prekindergarten through grade 12. Any teachers who did not receive a prepayment will be paid at that time.

Schools will also receive a spreadsheet entitled "Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program – Positions Detail." This spreadsheet lists each eligible teacher at your school along with the stipend amount that each teacher should receive. A copy of Florida Statute 1012.71 The Florida Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program is attached for your reference.

Schools With Internal Funds Checking Accounts:

- 1. Bookkeepers may begin writing Internal Funds checks to each individual teacher as shown on the "Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program Positions Detail" spreadsheet. This will cause the Internal Funds trust account 6.692.000 to be temporarily negative. These checks must be available for teachers on or before July 30, 2021.
- 2. When accepting the Internal Funds check, each teacher is required to sign The Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program agreement form (see attachment). The teacher agrees to keep all receipts and to spend the funds for the sole purpose of purchasing classroom materials and supplies to be used in the instruction of

students assigned to them. The teacher also agrees to return any unused funds to the school at the end of the school year.

3. A District check made payable to your school will be picked up by the courier on Thursday, July 22. You should receive the check the following week. Please deposit this check into your school's Internal Funds bank account. The deposit will then be entered into the accounting software and coded to account number 6.692.000.

Schools Without Internal Funds Checking Accounts:

- You will receive District checks made payable to each teacher at your school as shown on the "Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program - Positions Detail" spreadsheet. The checks will be put in the courier on Thursday, July 22. You should receive the checks the following week. These checks must be available for teachers on or before July 30, 2021.
- 2. When accepting the check, each teacher is required to sign The Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program agreement form (see attachment). The teacher agrees to keep all receipts and to spend the funds for the sole purpose of purchasing classroom materials and supplies to be used in the instruction of students assigned to them. The teacher also agrees to return any unused funds to the school at the end of the school year.

Special Notes for All Schools:

- If a teacher on your list has taken a classroom teacher position at another school, your school is still responsible for issuing the Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance program check.
- If a teacher on your list is no longer a classroom teacher, do not write the check. Those funds must be returned to the School District with a MIS 3218 Cash Transmittal Form no later than November 30, 2021. The funds will be allocated back to the Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program Project 3180 reserves.
- If a teacher does not spend all of his/her stipend prior to the end of fiscal year 2021-2022, the teacher must return the funds to the school as stated in The Teachers Classroom Supply Assistance Program agreement form. These funds must then be remitted to the School District with a MIS 3218 Cash Transmittal Form prior to June 30, 2022. The funds will be allocated to your school's Lottery School Advisory Council Project 2002.

Remember, each teacher on the school's list must have access to a check on or before July 30, 2021. The final allocation will be made in September for any additional teachers at your school.
