SUBJECT: Band Instrument Replacement Allocation - Project 2393

Mr. Chambers' commitment to Okaloosa County band programs in the form of unprecedented additional funding for instrument replacement was approved by the School Board on September 12, 2022. For the last several years, the Capital Outlay Budget has included an appropriation of \$50,000 for band instrument replacement. These funds have been allocated to high schools and K-12 one year and then middle schools the next. This year's budget includes an additional appropriation of \$350,000 to be allocated based on school level and band enrollment.

The attached spreadsheet details this year's allocation. It is divided into two sections:

<u>High Schools & K-12</u> – High schools and K-12 have been appropriated a portion of \$350,000 based on each school's band enrollment.

<u>Middle Schools</u> – Middle schools have been appropriated a portion of \$100,000 based on each school's band enrollment. In addition, the \$50,000 biennial allocation has been evenly split among the schools.

Allocations will be placed in the following funding strip: 3723-7400-0641-Center-2393. Each school will be able to enter requisitions using this funding and may <u>only</u> make budget amendments between object 0641 (Band Instrument Priced at \$5,000 or more) and object 0642 (Band Instrument Priced at less than \$5,000). The funds will be available to schools today.

Schools should contact the Purchasing Department regarding the process and procedures required for procurement of band instruments.
