Attention 7th Grade Students and Parents:

It is time for eligible 7th grade students to register for the Duke University Talent Identification Program (**TIP**) Talent Search. To participate, students must have scored at or above the 95th percentile on an accepted national standardized achievement test or state assessment test, or have a standard score of 125 or above (full scale or composite) on an accepted IQ test is no more than 2 years old. A 2017 FSA Level 5 scale score of 360 or greater for ELA or Math would be a qualifying test score. Educator recommendation is also acceptable.
