Attention 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Students and Parents:

It is time for eligible 7<sup>th</sup> grade students to register for the Duke University Talent Identification Program (**TIP**) Talent Search.

To participate, students must:

- Have scored at or above the 95<sup>th</sup> percentile on an accepted national standardized achievement test or state assessment test, or
- Have a standard score of 125 or above (full scale or composite) on an accepted IQ test is no more than two years old, or
- A 2018 FSA Level 5 scale score of 363 or greater for ELA or 361 or greater for Math would be a qualifying test score.
- Educator recommendation is also acceptable.
